As Ninety-Nines, women pilots, our mission is to promote advancement of aviation through education, scholarships, and mutual support while honoring our unique history and sharing our passion for flight. This scholarship is intended to assist women pilots in obtaining a new certificate/rating to advance to a new level of aviation.

Scholarship stipulations: We will award one scholarship to cover the check ride amount up to \$1000. The funds will be managed by the Dallas Chapter and be distributed as a reimbursement upon receiving a signed and dated receipt from the checkride examiner. The funds must be used for aviation training purposes only. The recipient must use the funds within one year from the award date.

PPL applicants must have passed the written and soloed. If for an advanced rating/certificate, applicant must have Private Pilot certificate, and have passed the associated written exam.

This scholarship is open to all applicants, with preference given to women residents of North Texas.

The scholarship winner will be notified by September 15. Winner may be asked to submit a photo and flying biography for publicity purposes.

Award Limitations: Scholarship winner will have 1 year to use the scholarship funds from the date award is issued. Applicants are not eligible to win more than one scholarship per certificate or rating per fiscal year from the Dallas 99s. The fiscal year runs from June 1 to May 31.
