The scholarship will cover the cost of a checkride, up to \$1,000. Applicant must be a member of the Dallas 99's Chapter as of the time of application submission. PPL applicants must have passed the written and soloed. If for an advanced rating/certificate, applicant must have Private Pilot certificate and passed the associated written.

Funds must be used within 12 calendar months of award date.

Funds will be awarded **October 15, 2023**.

The scholarship winner will be notified of the award by October 15, 2023 by the scholarship chairperson, and all funds will be paid directly to a certified flight school, flying club, or DPE. The scholarship winner will be obliged to submit a photo and flying biography for publicity purposes. Such publicity will only be used for The Ninety-Nines, Inc. objectives.

Award Limitations: Scholarship winner will have 12 months to use the scholarship funds from the date award is issued. Applicants are not eligible to win more than one scholarship per certificate or rating per fiscal year from the Dallas 99s. The fiscal year runs from June 1 to May 31.
